HUNTERSVILLE/ASHEVILLE, NC: Hinds' Feet Farm, a leader in Brain Injury Services for North Carolina, was recently awarded a \$45,000 grant from the Wells Fargo Foundation to support the Hinds' Feet Farm Veteran's Brain Injury Scholarship Fund. "We are extremely grateful to the Well Fargo Foundation for their generous contribution," said Martin Foil, Executive Director of Hinds' Feet Farm. The Wells Fargo grant will provide an opportunity for Veteran's to participate in Hinds' Feet Farm's innovative; community based and post rehabilitation day programs held at one of their two locations in Huntersville and Asheville, North Carolina.

In fact, their service to our military goes back more than 150 years, when many of its employees were called to military duty during World War I and World War II. Hinds' Feet Farm, a nonprofit organization, is dedicated to maximizing the post injury potential of persons living with brain injury through integrated, unique and holistic programs; allowing its members to pursue meaningful activities while developing a sense of belonging at home and in the surrounding communities. Scholarships for Veterans will be awarded based on need and on a first come-first serve basis. Brain Injury need not be directly service related.
